15-Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

¹⁹⁻Nevertheless, the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let everyone that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.

20-But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honor, and some to dishonor. 21-If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honor, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work. Iniquity is a violation of the right or duty that mankind is under obligation to do. An iniquity can also be a wicked act and immoral conduct or practice. These are harmful or offensive to society and, especially to God. In the bible, the terms, sin, and iniquity, are often used interchangeably.

What is iniquity in your heart? Iniquity is **the inner act of willfulness against God**.

It involves the attitudes of the heart.

How do we remove the Iniquity from our lives? What is the result of removing iniquity from our lives?

- To Make NEW! (Repent) (Forgive)
 - Starts with the renewing of your heart and mind.

Romans 12: 1 & 2

1-I Beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

2-And be not conformed to this world; but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God is?

Mosiah 1:52-60

^{52-I} say unto you, my brethren, that if you should render all the thanks and praise which your whole souls have power to possess, to that God who has created you, and has kept and preserved you, and has caused that ye should rejoice, and has granted that ye should live in peace one with another;

⁵³⁻ I say unto you, that if ye should serve him who has created you from the beginning, and art preserving you from day to day, by lending you breath, that ye may live and move, and do according to your own will, and even supporting you from one moment to another;

54- I say, if ye should serve him with all your whole soul, yet ye would be unprofitable servants. 55-And behold, all that he requires of you, is to keep his commandments; and he has promised you that if ye would keep his commandments, ye should prosper in the land;

56-And he never doth very from that which he hath said; therefore, if ye do keep his commandments, he doth bless you, and prosper you.

57-And now, in the first place, he hath created you, and granted unto you your lives, for which ye are indebted unto him.

60-And now I ask, Can ye say aught of yourselves? I answer you, Nay.

 - Can we consider that maybe we are not effective in our ministry and our approach of being disciples of Jesus Christ because we keep doing the same thing and some how expecting a different result?

²⁷⁻And now behold, I ask of you, my brethren of the church, Have ye spiritually been born of God?
